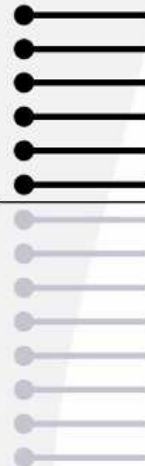

GDPR Compliance: Status Quo

- Updated Standard DPA provided by Atlassian ✓
- Including „Standard Contract Clauses“ (SCC) ✓
- Data subjects ✓
- Categories of data ✓
- Purpose of processing ✓
- Subprocessors, duties based on Art. 32-36 ✓



GDPR Compliance: All well then?

GDPR: Additional Aspects

- Data Residency Controls: What Primary- & Secondary data is available per region (= "Realm Pinning")
- Access restrictions: „IP Allowlisting“ vs. VPN
- Varying support for different products (Trello, Jira Align / OpsGenie / StatusPage)
- Third party apps – You might need individual DPAs
- Forge „hosted by Atlassian“ – Compliance in line with core products (Jira / Confluence)

Forge is ready for production

We're cutting the beta ribbon ✂️🎀: Forge is ready for production usage. This is the the next chapter for Forge, and we have many ahead to look forward to as we continue to build out the platform functionality. You'll see us continue to bring features out of beta (see below), but the platform today is ready to support your apps in production, at scale.

We know many of you are eagerly anticipating Marketplace integration for Forge, so I'll say it now: a Marketplace Early Access Program is starting in the next few weeks, with General Availability targeted for end of April. You can read more in the roadmap section below. But first, a few details about what production ready means for Forge.

GDPR Compliance: Edge Cases

- Highly regulated environments (Finance / Insurance / Healthcare)
- Additional compliance requirements (TISAX / VDA ISA)
- Data Residency (Primary & Secondary Data) & Centralization of user account data (Atlassian ID)
- Multi-geography use (in Cloud Free, Standard, Premium)



Post Privacy Shield / Schrems II



COUR DE JUSTICE
DE L'UNION
EUROPÉENNE

- „Privacy Shield“ has been invalidated for transfers of personal data between EU / US
- Standard Contract Clauses (SCC / model clauses) confirmed to be a valid mechanism for data transfers - but assumed not to be sufficient without additional terms / binding corporate rules (BCR)
- Additional transparency achieved through thorough analysis – i.e. data protection impact assessments (Datenschutzfolgenabschätzung)



Die sogenannten Standardvertragsklauseln, die europäische Unternehmen mit Anbietern in Drittländern abschließen können, um das europäische Datenschutzniveau auch in den Drittländern zu wahren, erklärt der EuGH dagegen unter bestimmten Bedingungen für grundsätzlich zulässig. Er betont in diesem Zusammenhang jedoch, dass sowohl die europäischen Datenexporteure als auch die Datenimporteure in Drittländern verpflichtet sind, vor der ersten Datenübermittlung zu prüfen, ob im Drittland staatliche Zugriffsmöglichkeiten auf die Daten bestehen, die über das nach europäischem Recht Zulässige hinausgehen (Rn. 134 f., 142 des Urteils). Bestehen solche Zugriffsrechte, können auch die Standardvertragsklauseln den Datenexport nicht rechtfertigen. Bereits ins Drittland übermittelte Daten müssen zurückgeholt werden. Anders als bisher verbreitet vertreten, genügt der reine Abschluss von Standardvertragsklauseln nicht, um Datenexporte zu ermöglichen (Rn. 126 ff. des Urteils).

Berliner Beauftragte für Datenschutz und Informationssicherheit

What exactly does this imply?

- Assessment is more complex and might require individual data protection impact assessment.
- Assess vendor legal structure: Atlassian „legal entities“ - Annex 3 in the DPA: Registered in the UK / HQ in Australia / Processing in the US – Assume export to third countries.
- Follow decision on “personal data flow“ of the UK/EU (Brexit)
- Assessment can be simplified based on features announced:
 - o Data Residency in Cloud Standard / Cloud Premium, Data Residency for Apps, Bring-your-own-key Encryption, Data Leak Prevention

Summary

- Atlassian has invested a lot in its native Cloud and offers a wide selection of Cloud plans
- GDPR compliance can be assumed based on SCCs / additional certifications / BCRs – individual assessment is required
- Utilizing additional documentation and certification a GDPR-compliant use is achievable
- Risk-assessment (data protection impact assessment) can be simplified with Data Residency Controls implemented in Cloud Standard / Premium and Apps ~Q3/2021.
- In highly regulated environments (Finance / Insurance) additional aspects need consideration – regulatory changes can be expected
